6.	<b>Description of content:</b> According to the announcement of the Government Gazette dated 22 January 2024, the suspension for the importation or transit of live poultry and poultry carcasses from the Philippines has expired on 22 April 2024. However, the WOAH has reported a continued outbreak of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) in the area of the Philippines. Therefore, it is necessary for Thailand to prevent the entry of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) disease into the country. By virtue of the Animal Epidemics Act B.E. 2558 (2015), the importation or transit of live poultry and poultry carcasses from the Philippines is temporarily suspended for a period of 90 days after the date of publication in the Thai Royal Gazette.
